



## Light of Christ Religious Emblem

<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Registered Tiger or Wolf Cub Scout of Catholic Faith.</li> <li>• The Scout must complete the requirements before starting third grade.</li> </ul>
<b>Purpose</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The purpose is to help the Cub develop a personal relationship with Jesus. With the parents' active assistance and participation in this program, it is hoped that the Cub will come to see Jesus as a real person and his friend.</li> </ul>
<b>Program Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To support the role of the parents as the primary catechists of their children.</li> <li>• To have the Scout identify Jesus as a real person and as his friend.</li> <li>• To foster early family religious involvement.</li> <li>• To be a stepping stone toward Parvuli Dei and the other religious emblems, when the parents are involved.</li> <li>• To serve as a catalyst to draw the parents into a deeper involvement with the church, through the child.</li> </ul>
<b>Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each Cub have his own Activity Book.</li> <li>• The book is designed for the Cub and his parent or guardian to work together.</li> </ul>
<b>Program Completion</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When the Cub completes all steps, he is presents the book to his parish priest or the priest's representative and the book is reviewed with the Cub.</li> <li>• After the priest or representative signs the book, it is sent to the diocesan chaplain for final approval.</li> </ul>
<b>Presentation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The emblem and knot may be presented at a diocesan or parish ceremony.</li> </ul>
<b>Scout's Role</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Actively work on the activities with his parents or guardians.</li> <li>• Keep the Religious Emblems Coordinator informed of his progress.</li> </ul>
<b>Parent's Role</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Actively work on the activities with their son. He may need your help with Bible readings and getting information.</li> <li>• Keep the Religious Emblems Coordinator informed of the Cub's progress.</li> </ul>
<b>Suggested Time Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One to ninety day(s).</li> <li>• Although the book could be completed in four to six hours, the goal of earning a religious emblem is to help the Cub develop a personal relationship with Jesus, so it is suggested that steps be spread over several weeks. This will help the Cub understand that this is a long-term commitment, not a one-time project.</li> </ul>
<b>Steps</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Step 1 - Families</li> <li>• Step 2 - God's Call</li> <li>• Step 3 - Eucharist</li> <li>• Step 4 - Forgiveness</li> <li>• Step 5 - Family of God</li> </ul>
